Collect some Autumn objects conkers, leaves, acorns, pine cones, etc) and use them for exciting collage or pattern making.

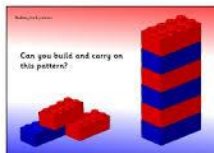
Use old magazines or newspapers and encourage your child cut out their favourite characters (with some adult help)
